This addendum takes precedence over work shown on the Plans and described in the Specifications and shall become a part of the Contract Documents. All work not specifically noted as changed or modified shall be furnished and installed as shown on original Drawings and as outlined in the original specifications.

Item #1: Sheet A4.1. Women's Restroom Floor Plan. The area in this room that has been previously excavated shall be filled with ABC in 8" lifts compacted to 90% Concrete "flow fill" may also

be utilized at the Contractor option.

- Item #2: All work must be complete by August 1, 2023.
- Item #3: Sheet A4, Keyed Note #10. These urinals that will be reused may be stored in the coliseum lobby or as directed by San Juan County staff.
- Item #4: Sheet P4.3. The new 2" water line to the building shall be copper where underground and where it goes under the stem wall and rises to the ceiling level. From this point it is the Contractor's option to continue to use copper or PEX piping.

The piping run between restrooms, Keyed Note #10 will run along the wall behind the bleachers.

Coordinate with the Architect/Owner what piping method will be purposed prior to installation.

Item #5: Detail 1/A4.1 Lavatory tops shall be supported by brackets as noted. These may be by Iron Supports, Federal Brace or similar. Solid surface material may be by LG Hi-Macs, Wilsonarts, Corian, Formica Everform. Solid surface material should be backed with 5/8" plywood.
