

REGULAR LOCAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to the Regular Local Election Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 1-22-2 to 1-22-19 (1969, as amended through 2019), I, Tanya Shelby, San Juan County Clerk, of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby issue the following:

That a Regular Local Election is hereby called to be held throughout the County of San Juan, State of New Mexico, and in each precinct thereof, on the 7th day of November 2023; and

That a Regular Local Election shall be a nonpartisan election, and the names of all candidates shall be listed on the ballot with no party or slate designation; and

That a Regular Local Election shall be applicable to the following local governments: City of Aztec, City of Bloomfield, City of Farmington, Town of Kirtland, Aztec Municipal School District, Bloomfield Municipal School District, Central Consolidated School District, Farmington Municipal School District, San Juan College, and San Juan Soil and Water Conservancy District.

That the Regular Local Election shall be for the purpose of permitting qualified electors to nominate candidates for the following offices:

Declarations of intent to be a write-in candidate for all elective local government offices shall be filed with the respective county clerk on Tuesday, September 5, 2023, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

ABSENTEE VOTING will be conducted at the San Juan County Clerk's Office, 100 South Oliver Drive, Suite 200, Aztec, New Mexico, commencing on Tuesday, October 10, 2023. The last day the County Clerk's Office can mail an absentee ballot to a voter is Tuesday October 24, 2023.

EARLY/IN PERSON VOTING will be conducted at the County Clerk's Office, commencing on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 during regular business hours, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Beginning Saturday, October 21, 2023, voting hours at the county clerk's office will be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The last day for all In Person/Early Voting will be Saturday, November 4, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.

IN PERSON/EARLY VOTING at alternate locations will commence on Saturday, October 21, 2023 and end on Saturday, November 4, 2023. The alternate locations and hours are as follows:

TO BE ELIGIBLE to vote in the upcoming Regular Local Election a qualified elector needs to be registered by October 10, 2023. However, a qualified elector may register to vote or update an existing certificate of registration at the County Clerk’s office during regular hours and days of operation beginning October 10, 2023 through November 4, 2023. A qualified elector may register to vote or update an existing certificate of registration at the County Clerk’s Office and at all Alternate Early Voting sites during regular hours and days of operation beginning October 21, 2023 through November 4, 2023. A qualified elector may also register to vote on election day, November 7, 2023 at any of the 33 San Juan County voting convenience centers between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
