Joe Sawyer, County Attorney, stated that District 3 State Representative T. Ryan Lane submitted a letter of resignation effective March 14, 2024, creating a vacancy until a newly elected State Representative takes office on January 1, 2025. New Mexico Statute 2-7F-4 Section B states that if a vacancy occurs in the office of representative and if the district is contained within a single county, the Commission may appoint a new representative to fill the vacancy. Mr. Sawyer indicated that the appointed representative's term will end December 31, 2024. Chairman Beckstead announced that interested applicants should submit a letter of interest to the County Executive Office by close of business on April 1st. These applicants will have the opportunity to present themselves formally at the April 2nd Regular Commission Meeting. The Commission made various comments.
