We wish to note the following exceptions: Precinct #1--Sanostee--Only 20 individuals registered as Democrats voted in this precinct, however Tom Atcity received 28 votes & James D. Atcity received 38 votes, both running on the Democratic Ticket 1 individual registered as Independent was permitted to vote. 1 Independent registered in 13-B, Shiprock was permitted to vote in this precinct. Precinct #14--Toadlena--1 individual registered as Independent was permitted to vote. Precinct #19--Naschitti--3 individuals registered as Independent were allowed to vote. #20--Crystal--Only 20 individuals registered as Democrats voted in this precinct, however Thomas E. Atcity received 39 votes & James D. Atcity received 45 & Johnnie Byrd received 35. All 3 of these candidates were running on the Democratic Ticket.
